Member born in January of this year via emergent cesarean section due to bleeding at 35wga. Birth weight of 5.7lbs unknown length. Mother had placenta previa and was hospitalized some during pregnancy on bedrest. Cesarean induction was scheduled, but members mother started bleeding, went to ER then on to have her cesarean section. Mother had adequate PN care. Member is African American, non-Hispanic and mother said he is Muslim. Mother speaks Arabic and their family support is in Sudan. He passed his hearing and vision exams. Member lives in a house with parents and big sister, mother reports they are safe there. Mother denies barriers to care, bill paying, obtaining food or transportation. Mother has an application for WIC but is not sure if she wants to be on it. Member needs assistance with all ADL's and parents are able to provide. Member was circumcised mother reports it is healed. Member stayed in the NICU for pneumonia, RDS and jaundice, he was discharged on 2/1 home. He is breast fed followed by formula if needed. Member is getting polyvisol QD. Member sees his pediatricain regularly. Member is up to date on vaccines. Education provided on VAB's, newborn care, bathing, safe sleep, feeds, milestones, breathing difficulties, what to watch for and when to call the provider, mother verbalized understanding. Mother desires for him to gain weight, not have breathing difficulties and meet milestones.
