CHRONIC VS ACUTE PAIN

- Chronic pain is pain that last beyond what would be expected based on the disease process
- Chronic pain and acute pain are two distinct entities

- History is the key
 - · When, where, how long?
- Chronic pain vs. addiction

 A good psychological history will be very beneficial

Doesn't have to be a formal assessment

Must assess substance abuse risk

DIAGNOSIS OF CHRONIC PAIN

- A specific diagnosis
- Do not use "chronic pain syndrome"

Be careful how you phrase things to patients

Avoid excessive diagnostic tests

Opioid use in chronic pain
