Member is a refugee from Malaysia. Member and her family came to the United States at the end of May of 2019. Member currently lives in 2 bedroom, 1 bathroom low income apartment with her parents and younger brother. Member was born in Burma and she did not cry at birth and the "traditional" remedy was done by dipping the vocal cord in cold water to get her to start crying. Member has never talked, crawled or walked. When member was 3 years of age she had diarrhea and was hospitalized and at that time she began to have seizures. Member had a femur fracture d/t seizure activity about 1 year before coming to the states. Member was struggling to eat and swallow study showed significant aspiration and G Tube was placed in 9/2019 and since then member has gained significant weight and 8/20 Wt. 85.5 lbs. Ht. 4' 6.72" Initial weight 6/5/19 was 44.9lbs.

School: Member has a para/teacher that comes to the home several times a week and therapists who come to the home.
