Blood Pressure

Systolic – when heart beats

Diastolic – at rest in between beats





Blood Pressure Categories



BLOOD PRESSURE CATEGORY	SYSTOLIC mm Hg (upper number)		DIASTOLIC mm Hg (lower number)
NORMAL	LESS THAN 120	and	LESS THAN 80
ELEVATED	120-129	and	LESS THAN 80
HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE (HYPERTENSION) STAGE 1	130-139	or	80-89
HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE (HYPERTENSION) STAGE 2	140 OR HIGHER	or	90 OR HIGHER
HYPERTENSIVE CRISIS (consult your doctor immediately)	HIGHER THAN 180	and/or	HIGHER THAN 120





Primary / Essential Hypertension Secondary Hypertension







Gestational Hypertension 6-8% of pregnancies

Risk Factors

- Previous gestational hypertension or preeclampsia
- Family history of gestational hypertension
- Have diabetes or gestational diabetes
- Have an immune disorder, such as lupus
- Kidney disease
- Expecting multiples
- Are black






Prevalence of Hypertension among Kansas Adults Aged 18 Years and Older, KS BRFSS, 2021






Prevalence of Hypertension among Kansas Adults Aged 18 Years and Older by Age Group, KS BRFSS, 2021





















Educational Attainment


