Delays to care*

Cost

• 1 in 3 postponed or avoided seeking medical care in the last year

Mistreatment

 1 in 3 had a negative experience or were mistreated by a mental health professional (2022)

Fear

• 1 in 5 did NOT seek needed medical care due to fear of disrespect or discrimination


Lack of insurance

• In 2019, uninsured rates were higher for LGBTQIA+ people than non-LGBTQIA (12.7% vs 11.4%)

Bills introduced into state legislatures

Legislation targeting LGBTQ rights more than doubled since last year

Number of anti-LGBTQ bills introduced in state legislatures each session





Progress towards inclusion

- Policies
 - Company policies that include non-discrimination based on sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression (SOGI)
 - Section 1557 of the ACA explicitly prohibits discrimination based on SOGI
- Inclusive patient and family care practices
 - SOGI fields in EHR
 - Staff training
- Employee benefits and celebrations
- Community engagement and advocacy



- Include opportunity to self-identify
