Member would like to have better mobility and walk independently through extended physical therapy and water therapy. Member has great perseverance and determination to complete this goal.

Member lives with father, 2 siblings, and grandfather while attending the 9 th grade. No social concerns.

Member's physical health conditions include: cerebral palsy, cholelithiasis, ovarian cyst, leg contractures, muscle wasting, dystonia and difficulty walking. Member has a stander at home and Member has had multiple surgeries dating back to 2018 and most recently 4/2025 for various leg problems including contracture and muscle wasting. In 2018 member had surgery to correct the head of the femur to correctly fit into the pelvis. Member's father assists member up to stander. Barriers to Treatment

Member was originally order to do physical therapy 3 times a week and to include water therapy in a pool. SHP denied this and only approved for twice a week. Member is to be re-evaluated for therapy in June and father is fearful that it will be denied. Father reports that member is making progress with PT twice a week but not as much gain as the specialist would like and he feels it is due to the reduced therapy.
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
