Member currently lives in a group home with roommates. She is not employed and enjoys leisure activities at the Day Service Program. No legal history, graduated high school with special education courses. Member is single, no children. Parents live 30 minutes from her.

Diagnosed with Down Syndrome, Scoliosis, Cortical Vision Impairment, Asthma, Heart Disorder AV Canal Repair, Pacemaker, hip and back surgeries. Very high risk for choking and has been hospitalized many times through the years for aspiration pneumonia. History of seizures as a child. Non-Verbal and has a wheelchair.

 Thick-IT #2 powder-all liquids thickened to honey consistency
