Social and Trauma History (Current living situation, employment status, pertinent legal history, level of education, relationship status, children, support system, etc.)

Member is currently incarcerated on misdemeanor charges. She previously lived in her own apartment successfully until the pandemic disrupted her routine and the services she received from the CMHC. She began declining support with her medications and daily living skills. In August of 2021 her treatment plan was ended by the CMHC for non-adherence to the plan. Reports of member asking others for money, causing disruptions in public and a decline of her self-care were reported by sister. Member stopped paying rent at her apartment and was in danger of being evicted for non-payment of rent. She also was bothering neighbors and throwing her trash out in the yard. Currently Supportive Housing Funds are being used to pay her rent however the landlord will not renew the lease effective 6.30.22. Upon her arrest at the end of March, the CMHC completed a state hospital screening for member and she was placed in a state hospital for several days. The hospital deemed she did not lack the capacity to make informed decisions for herself and discharged her back to jail with no OP treatment plan. Member remains in jail with a pre-trial arraignment at the beginning of May. Member is her own guardian and payee however has shown currently she lacks the capacity to pay her bills, take her medications, maintain her home or take care of her self-care and financial needs. While the hospital deemed her capable to make informed decisions, the CMHC states her needs are too high for their BH group home. Member is single and has no children. She has a sister that lives out of state and no other natural supports in the area. The sister previously was in contact with ladies from the laundry matt that member frequents, and they gave her updates on her condition from time to time.

Barriers to Treatment

Member refuses to sign most documents and often misrepresents her true self. Her MH status is a barrier to her treatment and ability to make appropriate decisions on her own behalf. Member will not engage with the CMHC. Member has no formal or informal supports at this time. Member will not have housing effective 6.30.22. No family member has come forward to petition for guardianship.
