- Member has been divorced multiple times
- When his 3rd wife was pregnant with their daughter, he was so overwhelmed that he left his wife, unborn baby, and home. A couple of months later, he returned to his family (now including a newborn daughter) and for the 1st time, went to a mental health ctr.
 - There, he was diagnosed with clinical depression and prescribed a small dose of antidepressant and talk therapy. By the next year, he was divorced and had a renewed ability to concentrate again on his work (very important to him).
- Soon also diagnosed with Bi-Polar
- Fired from his job over 30 years ago
- Lives alone currently. Recently reported that he realizes now that he had counted on intimate relationships to solve his problems, and/or make him whole.
- 2 adult children his daughter, from whom he's largely estranged, and a son whom he talks with, but not regularly
- Has a Master's degree in Computer Science, but a psychotic break down ended his career
