VIOLENCE AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

- Statistics are gruesome
 - 83% of women with disabilities will be sexually assaulted in their lives
 - 80% of women and 30% of men with developmental disabilities have been sexually assaulted
 - Half of these women have been assaulted more than 10 times
 - Just 3% of sexual abuses involving people with developmental disabilities are ever reported.
